3. Someone in my family is symptomatic with Covid-19 but I am well.	Risk of Infection to other people	All	2	2	4	Archer <u>must</u> refrain from coming to the Archery Range and Facilities for at least 14 Days.	1
4. Cross Contamination between bosses	Risk of Infection to other people	All	3	1	3	Bosses are to be placed at a minimum of 3.7 metres (4yds) apart in line with the marked shooting line positions travelling up the Archery Range. This provides a safe and AGB required space between Bosses and Archers. This is when either solitary shooting or as a family unit of no more than two when using two adjacent bosses.	1

Toilet facilities are only to be used in emergencies and with their express permission. The person using these facilities <u>must</u> disinfect the facility, their hands, and their equipment after use.	1
6. Cross contamination from Faces and Target Pins	Risk of Infection to other people.	All	3	1	3	All equipment required for shooting, including Faces and Target Pins must be brought to the Range by each archer and used solely by them.	1

8. Moving bosses to new distances	Risk of injury and Cross Contamination.	All	2	1	2	Gloves are to be utilised when moving bosses. Gloves help prevent splinter penetration and support reduction in cross contamination.	2
9. Equipment left behind by Archers when leaving the Range.	Cross contamination from Target Pins, Faces and archery equipment.	All	2	1	2	Any Target Faces, Pins and associated archery equipment left by Archers will be removed and discarded.	1
10. Becoming unwell whilst on the Archery Range.	Possible Infection may be passed on to another person.	All	3	1	3	Should you become unwell whilst at the Archery Range, you <b>MUST</b> immediately inform someone that you do so. If required, please arrange with someone any urgent support you will need when leaving the range.	1
